CT32 UNIVERSAL CUP

Universal Bases have removable cups that can be replaced with Universal Cups CT32-UCP-N and CT32-UCP-B. Universal Cup CT32-UCP-N and CT32-UCP-B can be used with CT40 model universal bases for charging only. They do not support data transfer.

CT32-UCP-N is for use with a CT32 computer without a boot. CT32-UCP-B must be used with a CT32 computer with a boot attached.

Out of the Box

Make sure that your shipping box contains the following:

Universal Cup (CT32-UCP-N/CT32-UCP-B)

If any items are missing or appear damaged, contact your Customer Account Representative. Keep the original packaging in the event that you need to return the scan handle for service or if you want to store the scan handle while not in use.

Replacing a Universal Cup

Note: The Universal Charge base is shown in the instructions below for illustration purposes. The steps for removing and inserting a cup are the same for all universal bases.

1. Push the latch towards the front of the base.



2. Tilt the back of the cup upwards.




3. Lift the old cup out of the base.



4. Insert the new cup tilted slightly towards the front of the base.



5. Push the cup into the base until it snaps in.



PROTECTIVE BOOT

Honeywell offers the following protective boot for use with a CT32:

CT32-PB-STD


Make sure that your shipping box contains the following:

Protective Boot (CT32-PB-STD)

If any items are missing or appear damaged, contact your Customer Account Representative. Keep the original packaging in the event that you need to return an item or if you want to store it while not in use.

Attach the Protective Boot

Insert the computer into the bottom of the boot then press down evenly.



Remove Protective Boot

Note: The boot does not need to be removed for battery replacement.

Routinely inspect the protective boot for damage and replace if needed.


- 1. Hold the unit on both sides with the screen facing toward you. Use your thumbs to apply even pressure to the lip of the boot.
- 2. Apply gentle pressure to the back of the unit to release the bottom of the unit from the boot.
- 3. Lift the unit up and out of the boot.



SINGLE CHARGE BASE

The CT32 single charge base can be used to charge one mobile computer. The CT32-SC-UVB Single Charge Base is boot-compatible. The CT32-SC-UVN Single Charge Base must be used with a computer without a protective boot attached.

- Single Charge Base (CT32-SC-UVN/CT32-SC-UVB)
- USB Type-C cable
- Product documentation


Connect Power

The power input to the CT32-SC single charging dock is 5VDC/2A. The operating temperature is -10 °C to 50 °C (14 °F to 122 °F). The maximum output of the base is 5VDC/2A.

- 1. Plug the supplied USB cable into the USB port in the rear of the base.
- 2. Connect the USB cable to a personal computer or plug the USB cable into the wall charger (P/N 50136024-001, sold separately) and plug the wall charger into a standard wall outlet.

Charge the Battery Pack

Insert the computer into the Charge Base (CT32-SC-UVN, CT32-SC-UVB). The unit will not charge unless a battery is installed.




UNIVERSAL QUAD CHARGING BASE

Universal Dock Quad Charging Bases CT32-CB-UVN and CT32-CB-UVB charge up to four mobile computers. Model CT32-CB-UVB is boot compatible.

Universal bases CT32-CB-UVN and CT32-CB-UVB have removable cups that can be replaced (see CT32 Universal Cup on page 3).


Connect Power

Use only a UL Listed power supply which has been qualified by Honeywell with an output rated at 12V/7A. The power supply input rating is 100-240 VAC, 50/60 Hz. The operating temperature is -10 °C to 50 °C (14 °F to 122 °F).

- 1. Plug the power cord into the power supply.
- 2. Plug the power supply cable into the power connector on the back of the charger.
- 3. Plug the power cord into a standard wall outlet.

Charge the Battery Pack

• Insert one to four CT32 mobile computers with battery pack inserted into the Charge Base.
